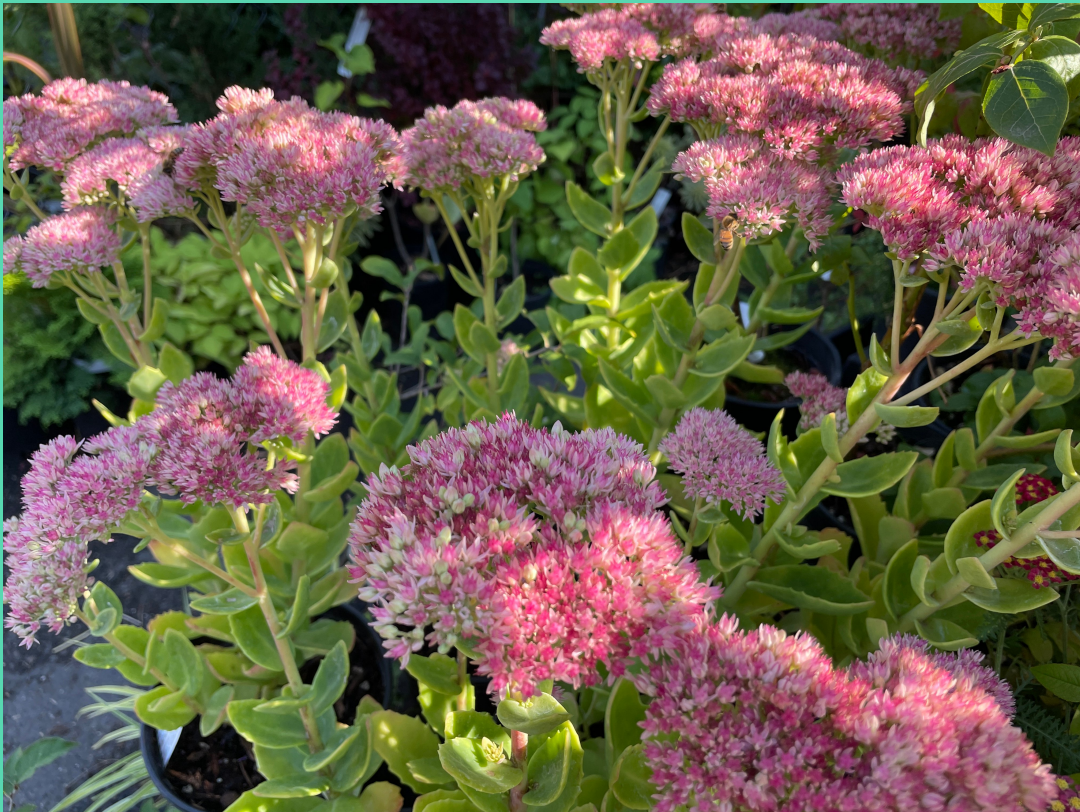


Goodbye Summer Fun, Hello Autumn Joy!

As summer draws to an end, and we wrap up the harvest of our warm-season veggies, it is time to clean up and tuck in beds for the winter with mulch or sow cover crops. Or extend your growing season by planting winter vegetables (broccoli, cabbage, kale, collards, and others) as well as garlic and shallots. Adding lime in the fall also preps your beds for vegetables next year.



Cover Crops

Keep your soil healthy by covering it with a thick layer of mulch, or sowing a cover crop. These seeds will put on growth and inhabit your garden all winter long, adding structure and nutrition while protecting your soil. Chop in and incorporate in spring before new plantings. We have crimson clover, fava, pea & oat mix, annual ryegrass, and daikon for fall sowing, as well as straw for mulching.



Organic Seed Garlic is Here!

September through November is prime garlic planting time! We have the following locally-grown and organic varieties available:

Softneck: Inchelium Red, Nootka Rose, Sicilian, Transylvanian

Hardneck: Duganski, Music, Persian Star, Romanian Red

Dutch Red Shallots



Spring Bulbs!

Plant tulip, daffodil, allium, muscari, and iris bulbs now for a welcome blast of spring color.

We also have native camas bulbs and fall-blooming saffron crocus bulbs available.

We have a great selection of drought-tolerant evergreen and deciduous shrubs such as Arctostaphylos, Manzanita, and Caryopteris to go into the ground now and build strong roots throughout the rainy season. We also have many native shrubs, perennials and grasses to choose from, aside from various other conifers, fruit trees, blueberry bushes, canes, flowers, ferns, and groundcovers ready to go in the ground.
